Spencer discussed the notice of funding opportunities for each of these grants, their deadlines, and eligibility for applying for the grants. Head inquired if NORTPO could help facilitate with grant writing for county bridges in the area. Spencer indicated that NORTPO is interested in working together with communities who would like to seek these grant opportunities. Spencer also discussed a new grant that wasn't on the agenda, PROTECT, Promoting Resilient Operations for Transformative, Efficient, and Cost-Saving Transportation Program. No action needed.

**C. Chisholm Trail MPO**

Eggers relayed updates on the status of the MPO in the Enid area which includes NODA as the prospective designee, plans for future meetings to discuss by-laws, and the official boundary. Flynn mentioned that ODOT will have specific GIS maps that will help determine if the boundary is at specific property lines. Eggers also discussed how the new MPO will have an impact on the RTPO demographic statistics.
