

**Northern Oklahoma Regional Transportation Planning Organization

June 28, 2018**

1. Call to Order/Introduction of Guests

Payton Herron called the meeting to order at 1:05 pm. Present: Valerie Snethen, Tyler Schroder. Absent: Junior Regier. A quorum was present. Staff Present: Cecil Michael, Vicki Eggers, Payton Herron, and Patti Lickliter. Guest: none.

2. Approve Previous Meeting Minutes

A. Alfalfa, Grant, Kay, Kingfisher, Major, & Noble Counties' Transportation Analysis Zone (TAZ) Maps.

Herron explained the zones for the population and answered questions the Technical Committee had on the Kingfisher County TAZ Map. C. Kingfisher County LRTP and their transportation goals.

D. The Planning Work Program (PWP) for the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2019.

The committee discussed the PWP FFY2019. Snethen moved to recommend the PWP for FFY2019 to NORTPO Policy Board for approval, seconded by Schroder. Motion carried. Aye: Snethen, Schroder. Nay: none.

E. The Joint Certification

Lickliter explained changes and updates from previous years. Schroder moved to recommend the Joint Certification to the NORTPO Policy Board for approval, seconded by Snethen. Motion Carried. Aye: Schroder, Snethen. Nay: none.

4. Set dated for July meetings.


