

Northern Oklahoma Regional Transportation Planning Organization
Technical Committee Meeting Minutes: Thursday, August 4, 2022

1. Call to Order/Introduction of Guests

Payton Herron called the NORTPO Technical Committee meeting to order at 1:02 PM. 2. Approve Previous Meeting Minutes from April 7th, 2022
