Participating in travel training can provide you and your loved ones with a sense of assurance when it comes to using public transportation independently. The training involves comprehensive instruction in a variety of areas, including but not limited to:

- Understanding bus rules and regulations
- Learning how to read a bus schedule
- Identifying landmarks to facilitate navigation
- Familiarizing yourself with bus pass procedures
- Developing appropriate public behavior
- Acquiring safety skills, such as:
 - crossing streets
 - recognizing signage
 - responding to emergency situations.

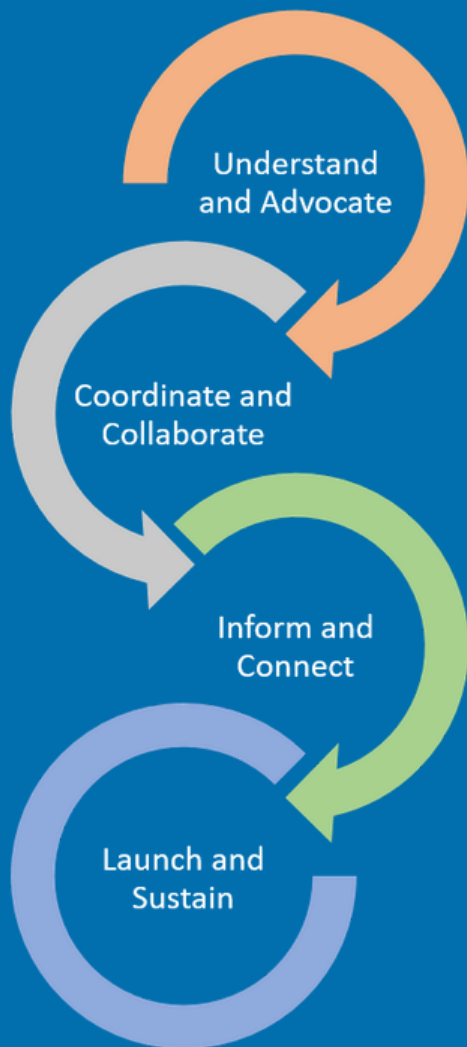

- Desarrollar un comportamiento público apropiado
- Adquirir habilidades de seguridad, tales como:
